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Top 5 Reasons to Choose Cleveland Elementary School

- 1.** Cleveland is a small learning environment with dedicated, highly qualified teachers. Many of our teachers have specialties and other talents that contribute to a well-rounded, collaborative environment. Cleveland students are exposed to an integrated learning environment that helps them make connections when learning new concepts. Cleveland teachers, staff, and volunteers strive to meet the needs of the whole child. Individual Learning Plans (ILPs) are used to monitor student's progress and set goals for students. Teachers collaborate with colleagues and instructional leaders to strengthen our practices to best serve our students. Students are given time to master the highest priority standards for what they need to learn and thrive.
- 2.** Cleveland has a focus on community building and leadership development. We take the time to get to know our families so that we can better serve them. We utilize our site-based resources (Family Center, school-based mental health services, parenting classes) and our community partners (East Arroyo Residential Association, Neighborhood Church, Reading Partners) to address the needs of our families. Cleveland strives to provide a safe, nurturing, patient, and encouraging environment for its students and its families. Our parents are encouraged to be leaders within the school community. Our community partners and adult education offerings help with developing our parents.
- 3.** Cleveland is a STEAM focus school. We provide a well-rounded educational environment in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math. These areas are integrated throughout all other curricular areas. We have a dedicated Science Room, Computer Lab, Music Room and Library. Students visit our specialty rooms on a weekly basis. We are proud to be partners with Education Through Music - Los Angeles which provides music education from a credentialed music teacher for all of our students, K - 5. Fourth and fifth grade students can choose to be involved in violin band.
- 4.** Cleveland is a beautiful school that is newly renovated. We have a new wing that houses a new front office, new Family Center, new classrooms, and our Computer Lab. Outside we have new playground equipment and a community garden. The community garden is an educational space and is used to teach about Earth Science, Health Science and Conservation.
- 5.** Cleveland organizes many community events every year to engage our community and showcase our students' accomplishments. Some of the events are Science Night, Family Dance - The Spring Fling, Game Night, Carnegie Hall @ Cleveland, a fundraising event featuring our students' musical performances, Literacy Night, and Winter Music Concert.
