- Cultural Compassion:** Students at McKinley School learn appreciation, tolerance, and understanding of other cultures and languages because of the cultural, linguistic and socio-economical diversity of the students and their families that attend our school. When kids learn about other cultures, it helps them understand and feel engaged in the world. - Outstanding and Dedicated Staff:** Many McKinley teachers and staff are founding members of the school, which reopened in 2002 as a visual and performing arts magnet school. All grade level teams work closely together to provide an arts-focused curriculum, and showcase at least one grade level performance every year.
- Involved Parents:** McKinley School has an outstanding PTA which hosts family and community events throughout the year including: Welcome Back to School Picnic, Harvest Festival, Art Night, Reading Night, Math Night, International Festival, Spring Egg Hunt, and Jog-A-Thon.
- Extra-Curricular Activities:** McKinley School serves busy working families with several excellent before and after school programs. These programs include: LEARNS, YMCA and Parks and Recreation.
- Early Childhood Education:** McKinley School has an excellent early childhood program that begins with extended transitional kindergarten. All ETK, T-K, Kinder and First Grade classrooms have an instructional assistant to provide extra support to students: as well as a CEIS (Coordinated Early Intervention Specialist) teacher who tutors qualifying students three times a week.
