What Makes Our School Unique?

At Daniel Webster School, we have a diverse teaching staff with at least 35 employees who speak at least one other language besides English. Languages we speak include English (British and American), Spanish (all dialects), Armenian (both dialects), Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Russian, French, Turkish, Italian, Portuguese, American and Spanish sign languages just to name a few.

Our teaching staff is encouraged to relate all lessons to the real life in order for the students understand why they are completing a task or project, but more importantly, they are developing a better cultural awareness.

Recent Accomplishments

- 19% Increase in ELA on CAASPP; and
- 9% Increase in Math on CAASPP;
