- **IB Programme** - Primary Years Programme (PYP)
- **IB Learner Profile:** The profile aims to develop students who are inquirers, thinkers, principled, knowledgeable, communicators, risk-takers, reflective, open-minded, balanced, and caring.
- **Instrumental Music:** Students in first through fifth grades study a musical instrument. First graders study the keyboard, second graders learn the recorder, third grade students take Suzuki violin, fourth grade students study guitar, and fifth grade students learn the keyboard.
