



JOIN OUR **FAMILY**

If you live within the Don Benito Attendance Boundary...

- Registration begins on November 29th
- Student must turn five years old on or before September 1, 2022
- Register online by going to https://www.pusd.us/enrollment
- The following documents will be required at registration:
 - Your child's birth certificate
 - Your child's most recent immunization record
 - Two documents showing proof of residency:
 - Recent gas, electric or water bill in parent/guardian's name
 - A deed of trust, mortgage payment receipt, rental receipt with a copy of the lease agreement, or a property tax bill in parent/guardian's name
 - Most recent Individualized Education Plan (IEP), as applicable if child was previously determined eligible for special education services.

 - Apply January 10, 2022 through January 28, 2022
 - Results available online on February 17, 2022
 - Register at your school of choice February 18, 2022 through February 28, 2022

 - Results available online on March 18, 2022
 - Register at your school March 21, 2022 through March 25, 2022
