Students:

Continue to conduct a daily COVID Safety Self Evaluation for wellness at home and follow all COVID Safety Protocols on campus:

Mandatory temperature checks and hand sanitizer upon arrival.

Masks are required and must be worn properly - covering the mouth and nose. Masks are required during all afterschool activities such as games, tutoring, and after school programs.

Use hand sanitizer and wash your hands often.

Practice social distancing.

Food Deliveries: food deliveries are not permitted on campus for safety reasons. Marshall has free lunch for all students, every day. Additionally, there is no food permitted in our sports complex. Only water and sports drinks such as Gatorade are allowed.

Vandalism: vandalism will not be tolerated on our campus. Last week we had several soap dispensers broken off of our student restroom walls. Students will be held accountable with swift consequences including suspension and removal from school activities. Additionally, students responsible for damage to school property may be held financially liable. Respect our beautiful campus!

Parents:

PUSD will resume the COVID-19 PCR testing for students and staff during this week. The COVID-19 Response Team will be at Marshall to offer testing to students and staff on Mondays from 8:00am - 12:00pm, in front of our Sports Complex.

Students and staff will have to register with the COLOR system prior to arriving for testing. Informed consent will be collected through the electronic registration process. If your student has tested with PUSD before, they will not have to register again.

The COVID-19 test is a nasal swab PCR test that the students can self-administer under the supervision of a PUSD nurse. Testing materials are provided by Valencia Lab and results will be received within 24-48 hours.

Students and staff will need to go to the testing location outside of the Marshall Sports Complex. Please bring a form of identification to check in for testing.

If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, do not come to school for testing. Other testing locations include:

Tuesday - Friday, 8:00-3:30: PUSD Primary Care Clinic at 351 S. Hudson Ave. Please call 626-396-3600 xt 88180 for an appointment.

Monday - Sunday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. : ChapCare's Kathryn Barger Health Center at 1595 N. Lake Ave.
