NOTICE INVITING INTERESTED CONTRACTORS FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS FOR PASADENA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Pasadena Unified School District is prequalifying General Contractors to bid on public works projects. The District has two levels which will require pre-qualification.

Categories for Contractor Pre-Qualification:

- Projects valued between \$2,000,000-\$9,999,999
- Projects valued at \$10,000,000 or more

Contractors may select to be considered for prequalification in either or both of the above Prequalification Categories.

As a condition of bidding and to perform Projects funded by Measure TT and/or State Bond funds, and in accordance with California Public Contract Code 20111.5(e), the Pasadena Unified School District requires Contractors to complete a prequalification questionnaire and a financial statement. Contractors are required to have a current license and be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations. Contractors are subject to verification through the Contractors State License Board and the Department of Industrial Relations. Any contractor previously approved as a pre-qualified contractor with Pasadena USD for large projects during the 2016 calendar year will need to re-apply for projects bid in the 2017 calendar year.
