# YOUTH IN FOSTER CARE SUPPORT SERVICES



## STUDENT DETERMINATION

- All youth with an open dependency (abuse/neglect) case in juvenile court, either in out-of-home placement (relative, foster parent, or group home).
- Living with their parents or guardians under court supervision.
- All youth with an open delinquency (probation) case in juvenile court who are in an out-of-home placement.



#### STUDENT SERVICES

#### COUNSELING SUPPORT

- Individual Counseling
- Transitional Counseling
- Linkage to school-based and community resources
- Transcript analysis
- Support in identifying
- AB 167/216 eligibility
- Serves as a liaison between schools, group homes, substitute care providers, and placing agencies to ensure educational needs.
