By the numbers, **teachers...**

- 114 certified GATE teachers
- 71 teachers in the process of certification
- 44 hours of PD offered with 24 additional hours of coaching per participant
- 17 hours of A Monday Staff Professional Development
- 75 hours of collaboration with Instructional Coaches at Coaches weekly
- 28 GATE site representatives attend monthly meetings/PD

By the numbers, **students...**

- 1,784 identified students in grades 3-12 (10% of total population of students)
- 17,817 total students enrolled in PUSD (12/7/2017)
- 40% (705) of identified students are Hispanic/Latino
- 10% (178) of identified students are African American

New Identification: 2017-18

- 1661 students tested (all second graders and students (grade 3-8) new to the district)
- 76 students identified in initial round - *Intellectual Ability* category
- ~an additional 175 students identified through the *Secondary Review Process*
 - 30 in *Creative* category, 76 in *High Achieving* category, 69 in *Intellectual* category
