Spirit Points will also be awarded for the class that buys the **most** Homecoming Dance tickets. Come down to center/east quad and join the fun with your class! Check the bulletin or posters on campus for more information on these activities. Which class has the most spirit - who'll win Spirit Week?

MONDAY: Jersey Day/Obstacle Course – Wear your favorite MLB, NFL or any team jersey! Join the fun in center quad at lunch and see which class wins the obstacle course! Winners will win spirit points for their class!

The Annual "HOMECOMING - Beat Muir" Assembly - will take place this afternoon location TBA. The Homecoming Court will be featured and the **Queen will be crowned!** Fall athletic teams will also be featured. Cheer, Orchesis, band and pageantry corps will perform. PLEASE NOTE: A special bulletin will be forthcoming with the time frame for the assembly on Friday.

The Annual TURKEY TUSSLE* – PHS vs. Muir varsity football game is at the Rose Bowl. **PHS fans enter at Gate C.** Ticket redemption begins at 4:45pm and gates open at 5:15. Pre-game ceremony starts at **5:45pm** with the introduction of Homecoming Courts and senior football players from both schools. Kick-off is at **6:30pm**. PHS will play to retain the Victory Bell! Admission is **free** to PHS & Muir students with ASB cards. General admission is **\$12***. Students without ASB, senior citizens and children 6-13 are **\$5**. There is a **\$10 parking fee** per vehicle. Tickets are **not** sold at school. They can only be purchased **online** through *GoFan*. The site* will go live soon. Listen for announcements at school or emails with the link for ticket information. **Please note:** All concessions at the Rose Bowl are cashless – a debit or credit card will be needed to purchase food and drinks.

SATURDAY: HOMECOMING DANCE - is tonight at Santa Anita Park from 7:00-11:00pm. Please see the special bulletin for information. Tickets are **not** sold at the door. Tickets must be pre-purchased at school by October 22nd.

ASB will award \$850 in cash prizes to the winning classes for Spirit Week activities and campus decoration:

1st Place - \$500 **2nd Place** - \$250 **Consolation** - \$100

In order to discourage students from vandalizing campus as a "display of school spirit," a **\$500 fine** will be imposed on any class disqualified for breaking contest rules. The money will be taken from that class treasury and placed in the ASB General Fund. Designated admin, faculty, and staff will be the judges of Spirit Day. All winners will be announced at the assembly.

CAMPUS DECORATING RULES:

- The campus is divided into four sections with each class responsible for decorating their designated area:

Center Quad	- Senior Class '22	Between E & I Building	- Sophomore Class '24
East Quad	- Junior Class '23	Upper Center Quad (in front of H bldg.)	- Freshman Class '25
- No students are to be on campus for decorating **before** 6:00am on Thursday morning. The faculty advisor or representative **must** be present during the decorating. Each class is responsible for cleaning their section **before the end of Per. 3.**
- No persons are to go onto or are objects to be placed on top of any buildings or on walkway covers.
- The following items are NOT allowed and are grounds for disqualification: a). NO vehicles will be allowed onto campus. b.) NO alcoholic beverage containers or anything that can be interpreted to represent alcohol or drugs. c). NO real estate, street or traffic signs. d). NO street barriers or pylons. e). NO toilet, crepe or tissue paper and/or confetti. f.) NO signs using profanity or making derogatory statements. g). NO paint or other markings not on paper (except chalk). h). Any item obtained illegally. i). Any posters with the word killer/killla on them or other vulgar words. The Assistant Principals and ASB Advisor will be the judges that determine disqualification.
- NO** work for Spirit Week (except by ASB Publicity Committee) is to be done during school hours (8:30am-3:45pm) or in G-106. Poster painting may take place on weekends and at homes. **No materials from G-106 may be used by any class.**
