What Makes Our School Unique?

We provide a research-based Mandarin Dual Language Immersion Program model with target language and English instruction provided exclusively by separate teachers. Students receive a true immersion experience since Mandarin teachers do not break language. This program is supported by a variety of enrichment and extracurricular activities. These include: Math Field Day, LA County Science Olympiad, Chinese Poetry Contest, Innovation Club, integrated arts instruction, Chess Club, STEAM enrichment instruction and integrated Technology Program through 1:1 Chromebooks.

What Does Our School Offer?

Research shows that early acquisition of a foreign language impacts academic success and early acquisition of Mandarin and Simplified Chinese increases cognitive development. Our Mandarin Dual Language Immersion Program (MDLIP) is an aggressive approach towards building literacy in Mandarin and English through the 90/10 model—90% of Kindergarten instruction is in Mandarin and 10% is in English. Additional components of our MDLIP include:

- 1. Pre-Kindergarten to Fifth Grade classes
- 2. Mandarin teachers only provide instruction in the target language
- 3. Formative and Summative Assessments conducted in both languages.
- 4. Sister school relationship with HuangChengGen Elementary School in Beijing, China.
