What Makes Our School Unique?

Madison Elementary staff and parents have worked very closely with Pasadena City and Pasadena Unified School District personnel to create a "City-School Collaboration Initiative". Our community partners work with students, parents and staff to enrich our academics. Volunteers provide tutoring, mentorship, school supplies and field trips. We take care of the whole child providing both academic and social-emotional services when needed.

What Does Our School Offer?

Learning is a team effort at Madison Elementary. Our shared leadership model builds great partnerships among students, parents, staff and the community which promotes our belief that every child is important and has potential for success. Our instructional program teaches a multitude of skills which are integrated into all academic areas. Students are involved with STEAM projects and labs from pre-school through fifth grade. Our fourth and fifth grade students participate in Music, Science Innovation Club, and various district competitions. Our after-school programs provide extra-curricular activities such as sports teams. In addition, fourth and fifth grade students are invited to a unique LEADERSHIP program wherein they are mentored by high school and college students.

Top 5 Reasons to Choose Madison

1. Dedicated and collaborative staff that is focused on student academic outcomes

Madison Elementary teachers collaborate on common core standards to make curriculum accessible to all students. We've purposefully included 21st Century skills, inquiry-based activities and engagement strategies into our daily lesson delivery.

2. Safe School Environment

Staff and students are respectful towards each other. We take great pride in building relationships with all students and teaching them how to be "RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE AND SAFE" citizens.

3. **STEM**

We have a science teacher that works with grade levels to coordinate instruction for all students. We've started a community garden with the help of community partners. We also have collaborated with PCC, JPL, LA Astronomers Club, and Caltech for tutoring and enrichment experiences.

4. Community School

The district, city and school collaborate to create partnerships that benefit our children and bring real-world experiences into the classroom. We have volunteers from the community providing services for our families and academic opportunities to our students. For example, one partnership has helped create "5th grade leadership", wherein MESA students from PCC and Marshall work with the 5th grade on service project learning.

5. Family Center

In study after study, researchers discover how important it is for parents to be actively involved in their child's education. When parents are involved in their children's education at home, they do better in school. And when parents are involved in school, children go farther in school — and the schools they go to are better. Positive results of parental involvement include improved student achievement, reduced absenteeism, improved behavior, and restored confidence among parents in their children's schooling. At Madison Elementary, we have workshops and classes that parents are encouraged to attend.
