HOW WE DISCOVER YOUR CHILD'S GIFTS

Enrich Personal Achievement – We believe that learning is personalized by a variety of criteria. We foster problem solvers who are independent thinkers, self-motivated, and engaged learners in a collaborative environment. *We begin with the end in mind. Be proactive.*

Develop Effective Communicators – We are a model school for Reader's Workshop and Writer's Workshop. Through a Balanced Literacy approach, we develop effective communicators who *seek first to understand, then to be understood.*

Explore Creativity – We ignite students' artistic passions using different mediums of the creative arts. We offer 2nd grade recorder, 3rd grade violin, orchestra and band for 4th and 5th grade during the school day. Choir is available for all grades after school. We have a signature ceramics program for all students taught by a gifted artist whose desire is to teach children to go below the surface into the Earth element that connects all of us. Through hands on exploration, we nurture brilliance and versatility developing a well-rounded child. This is how we *sharpen the saw.*

Foster Innovation – Through scientific exploration, we equip students with the ability to analyze and solve complex problems through interactive instruction with a collaborative approach. We offer coding classes for Kinder and 1st grade as well as a Science Lab for weekly instruction for all grades. Before school, we also offer STEAM and GATE Club activities as an additional enrichment opportunity. *Synergize.*
