Pasadena Unified School District (PUSD) CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE (COC) MEETING Minutes of Meeting held on September 23, 2020

- I. Meeting called to order 6:37pm
 - a. Present: John Robinson, Amelia Bradford, Eliza Jane Whitman, Kim Kenne, Miguel Perez, Leonard Hernandez, Dr. Leslie Barnes, Judy McKinley & Angela Childs
- II. Public comments
 - a. none
- III. Approval of August 2020 meeting minutes
 - a. Eliza Jane Whitman provided comments so minutes will be approved next month.
- IV. Review of Action Items from August 2020 Meeting
 - a. Blair track funding was provided after the August 2020 COC meeting.
 - b. Revisited the request for assumptions between artificial and natural turfs. Facilities will provide if the Muir/PHS artificial turf projects move forward.
- V. Review of TT related Board Reports
 - a. none
- VI. Board of Education COC Liaison Report
 - a. The district's budget was not approved for the 2020-2021 school year due to a delay with the County of Los Angeles.
 - b. Reviewed MTT Central Admin Expenditures document provided by Kim Kenne. Staff vacancies will result in a lower expense. If Measure O passes, they will likely be positioned that are filled. Staff time gets allocated to specific projects as their time is billed but begins being funded by this central admin account. The increase of Owner's Representatives (inspectors, construction managers, project managers) in 2019-2020 but a significant decrease in legal fees.
 - c. LA County is listed as Purple status for COVID in the California Department of Public Health chart. Districts in the red status such as San Diego and Orange County are able to open schools but not necessarily deciding to do so. PUSD Parents and staff also need to be in agreement that schools should open based on the safety procedures put in place. PUSD has not made a decision about when to reopen.

- d. School related items on the November ballot include Measure O and School Board Seats 2, 4 and 6.
- e. District expenditures update There have been savings on transportation and some specialists, but also certain one-time expenditures for training and technology needs.
- f. Measure O Update: Information will be provided to the community on the PUSD website that will be updated next week. A mailer will go out as soon as it is printed from PUSD for all Pasadena residents. Communication needs to be as broad as possible to school communities and all residents. Webster pages in the presentation are an example of the needs analysis, not a guarantee that the projects listed will be prioritized and funded. Once the needs analysis is completed for all schools it will be funneled down into a project prioritization. Item 12 on suggested improvements "intelligent new construction" this needs to be more definition.
- g. It was questioned if the Measure TT COC can be rolled over to Measure O. Dr. Barnes indicated that this would be the plan but allowing for current members to continue to volunteer at will. Because there are currently fewer than the minimum required members for the current Measure TT COC, this will be an opportunity to recruit additional members.

VII. Facilities Reports

- a. Consolidated Budget Status by Funds Blair middle school reconciled. How is the board going to determine how to spend the uncommitted available funds currently at \$3.395M? Determined that Muir and PHS football fields would not be upgraded. PUSD Board decided not to spend the uncommitted available funds before they know if the Measure O bond passes. If not, it will be saved for emergencies. Potentially PHS Identity project could be re-scoped.
- b. Consolidation Status Report PHS project was delayed because of the fires and smoke in the air but still on track to be finalized by end of October 2020. Blair Elevator Upgrade/Modification notice to award was issued to the Contractor and scheduled to be completed late January 2021.
- c. Pictures of Facilities Department Active MTT Projects provided in the meeting materials.
- d. Quarterly DSA Closure status There hasn't been any additional projects closed since June. Ned is researching an old project. COC requests that the closure status be spell checked, write up expanded to show progress and presented at the October COC meeting. There needs to be more progress if we are paying for fulltime service to close projects. In addition, Architects should not be paid by PUSD their final payment if they are not providing documentation to close projects which several projects cannot be closed due to missing documentation from Architects.

- III. Approval of August & September 2020 meeting minutes
 - a. August 2020 meeting minutes approved
 - b. Steve was present for the September 2020 meeting. September 2020 Meeting minutes approved with the change.
- IV. Review of Action Items from September 2020 Meeting
 - a. None
- V. Review of TT related Board Reports
 - a. None for the second month
- VI. Board of Education COC Liaison Report
 - a. Budget consolidation is still in progress.
 - b. School openings PUSD will open schools no sooner than January 11th. Required steps include LA county moving into tier that would allow the schools to open, agreement with the Pasadena Health Department regarding the opening and finalizing negotiations with the teacher's union. On Monday, October 26th, small group cohorts of special ed and English learners will return to campus but will remain under 10% of the student population. Students will participate in remote learning because teachers will not be present. After school LEARNs has been taking place for elementary and middle school. A new way of conducting inperson learning has been proposed which would live stream teacher's lessons. This would allow for the same instruction for students regardless of being inperson or at home.
 - c. Measure O update marketing has been received by Pasadena residents. The school needs assessment is posted on the Measure O website: https://www.pusd.us/Page/8883. According the Dr. Barnes, the facilities master plan will be started after the bond passes because of the expense that will be

incurred to complete it. Measure TT website provides an overview of all projects completed under that bond. It was requested that the website provide an overview of all projects completed under Measure Y.

VII. Facilities Reports

- a. Consolidated Budget Status by Funds—no questions from the COC. The remaining funds will be kept separate from new Measure O funds if the measure is passed. Remaining Measure TT funds would need to be utilized in accordance with the bond language from Measure TT, not Measure O. COC recommends looking for other source of funds for projects such as EV charging stations and non-potable water irrigation project at John Muir.
- b. Construction Status Report –Two projects are not measure TT related; EV Charging stations and John Muir PWP Irrigation Water. It was recommended to keep these on the Construction Status Report but label them non-Measure TT.
- c. Pictures of Facilities Department Active MTT Projects reviewed by COC

- b. Item 2 DSA closeout confirmed today (10/21/20)
- c. Item 3 10 still working to complete for closure. Going forward, we would like to understand if it will cost Measure TT money to close out the remaining projects. COC recommends adding the outstanding issue to the summary, action items to complete projects and an anticipated timeline for closeout. As a follow up to the June 24th meeting Facilities provided a DSA Closure Status Report that included 19 projects of which only 10 are shown on the 10-21-20 DSA Closure Status Report. Were the projects listed in the June report closed out? Facilities will reconcile the report from June and the report provided for this meeting to review next month. If Measure O passes, we cannot open new projects at a school site if there is an open project with the DSA.
