Examples that qualify as community service:

Volunteer work for a church, school, at a park, youth camp, doing neighborhood clean up, or any similar nonprofit service work or organization.

Tutoring other students within a tutoring program.

Volunteer work for a political campaign.

Helping teachers, counselors, administrators, or other campus workers.

Baby sitting at a nonprofit function.

Examples that do not qualify as community service:

Helping out at home.

Helping relatives, e.g., parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins.

Working in a family business.

Working without pay in a profit-making business.

Baby sitting for a neighbor, whether paid or unpaid.
