Distance from Met (DFS) refers to the average distance in scaled score unites from the minimum score considered at grade-level standard (i.e. the lower limit for level 3 – standard met).¹

Due to the Coronavirus pandemic, the California Department of Education suspended mandated CAASPP testing.²
