In this report, the results from PUSD's Covid-19 Needs Assessment Survey are disaggregated by stakeholder group (i.e. students, parents, school-level staff, and district-level staff). The survey aims to gather feedback from students, their parents, staff, and administrators, including their concerns regarding Covid-19 related school closures, how well PUSD is supporting students' academic success and social-emotional well-being, whether students and staff have access to the tools and technology to support online learning, and what additional resources and supports respondents would find useful.


PUSD students, parents, staff, and administrators were invited to participate in this web survey through email/phone messages, messages through Aeries (Student Information System) Student, Teacher, and Parent portal home pages, a message posted on PUSD's District website, and through social media on PUSD's Facebook and Twitter accounts (and those of community partners who shared).

The survey was administered by Hanover Research, a research firm which provides the District research services in coordination with PUSD's Office of Research, on the Qualtrics survey platform and was open April 26 – May 3, 2020. Across stakeholder groups, 2,043 unique respondents participated and provided 2,296 completed survey responses because parents were given option to complete survey again for additional children.


The phrasing of questions and answer options were tailored to each stakeholder (e.g. "I am," My students are"), and some items were only shown to certain stakeholders. For simplicity and brevity, this report adopts direct phrasing for some questions (e.g. "Do you") and neutral, generic terminology for answer options (e.g. "Students are...").

Q2. Which of the following best describes your relationship to PUSD? (shown only to school and district staff)








Q4. What grade are you in? (Shown only to students, parents, and instructional staff)




Q5. Which school [do you/do you primarily teach*/does your child] attend? (Only shown to instructional staff)








Physical health, Mental Health, and Well-Being

Q8. Please indicate how much you disagree or agree with the following statements about your concerns:






Childcare Needs of Staff

Q11. If you were to participate, how many children would you be enrolling in childcare services through PUSD? (shown only to school and district staff)





Q12. Please select the ages of any children who would participate in childcare services though PUSD. (*Multi-select item, does not sum to 100%*)




Q13. Are you interested in receiving free meals for your children between ages 1 to 18 while the district is implementing remote learning?



Q14. How many children in your household are you picking up (or interested in picking up) free meals for? (Shown only to parents participating or interested in participating; Q13)





Q15. Meals are available for pickup from 9-11am at seven PUSD school sites. Which of these locations would be most convenient for you to pick up meals?


Q16a. How useful would the following resources or supports be to you?







Q16b. How useful would the following resources or supports be to you? (Shown only to staff; Q2)




