





1. During which times did your student participate in the Remote Learning Program?





2. Please select which resources your student was able to access while participating in the Remote Learning Program during the spring between 03/16/20 and 05/28/20.

















9. During remote learning, did you have internet access in your home?













14. [OLD VERSION] Which of the following successes have there been related to distance learning?






