



CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENT ATHLETES

INTRODUCTION: The purpose of the conduct expectations for Student Athletes is to provide all LEARNs athletes guidance on acceptable behavior. Following all of the expectations and conduct rules will greatly reduce the possibility of conflict and disorder before, during, and after all games. It must be understood that failure to follow these expectations may result in loss by forfeiture or disqualification for the teams. It may also result in disciplinary action for LEARNs students.

All LEARNs Student Athletes are required to agree with all of the following:

1. AVOID ALL VERBAL AND PHYSICAL CONFRONTATION OF ANY TYPE WITH ANYONE
2. MAINTAIN A POSITIVE ATTITUDE AT ALL TIMES.
3. STUDENT ATHLETES MUST USE APPROPRIATE LANGUAGE. NO PROFANITY OR OFFENSIVE REMARKS MUST BE MADE.
4. NEVER DISPLAY ANY TYPE OF UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT OR GESTURES BEFORE, DURING, AND AFTER THE GAME.
5. DEMONSTRATE CARE FOR OTHERS; NEVER INTENTIONALLY INJURE ANY PLAYER OR ENGAGE IN RECKLESS BEHAVIOR THAT MIGHT CAUSE INJURY TO OTHERS OR SELF.
6. NEVER CONFRONT, HARASS, OR THREATEN ANY PLAYERS FROM AN OPPOSING TEAM.
7. DO NOT HARRASS, INTIMIDATE, OR ARGUE WITH A REFEREE.
8. STUDENT ATHLETES MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THE GAME.
9. STUDENT ATHLETES MUST LINE UP AND SHAKE HANDS AFTER THE GAME.
10. ALL STUDENT ATHLETES ARE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION IF THERE ARE SERIOUS VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT. THIS INCLUDES REMOVAL AS A PLAYER, SUSPENSIONS, AND UP TO TERMINATION FROM THE PROGRAM.
