GRADUATION CEREMONY - will be held at the Pasadena Civic Auditorium at 1:00pm. May 31:

Seniors MUST check-in 1½ hours prior to start. There will be a 5 quest ticket limit /allowance per senior. Please plan accordingly. Extra tickets may be available for purchase for \$15.00* each (maximum 1 or 2 extra tickets) for the first 150 seniors who request them. Orders will be filled in the order in which they are received with cash payment. Look for more information in the Graduation Agreement/Ticket Order form

that will be mailed to all senior families on or approximately the week of April 24th.

GRAD NITE - at Disneyland/California Adventure. 1:00pm-2am. (See February 14th for June 2-3:

ticket sales information). Seniors will board the buses at 12:30-1:00pm. They will arrive at <u>Disneyland</u> between 2:30-3pm and stay until the park closes at 10:00pm. The fun continues at the California Adventure Grad Nite Party until 2:00am. Students must ride

on the bus to and from Disneyland – NO exceptions. Buses return to PHS 3 - 4:00am.

Tickets or other items purchased with checks that are found to be NSF will be rescinded or revoked until payment is rectified. Seniors MUST have: their current I.D. card, signed contract/parent permission slip, be clear of all financial, textbook and any other obligations to PHS, affiliated companies or PUSD and not be in violation of the Attendance Policy in order to buy tickets and participate in any senior activity.
