Vacant SSC Chair Greetings Bulldog Families,

In December of 2017, construction began on our modernization projects for both gymnasiums, as well as both the boys' and girls' locker rooms. This modernization project is part of the Measure TT Bond passed in 2008. The project is divided into two phases, with the first phase focused on the south gymnasium, boys/girls locker rooms, trainer's room, and the entrances and surrounding areas of the south gymnasium. The second phase of the project will focus on the north gym. This portion is slated to begin in the Spring of 2018.

As of September 6, 2017, here is where we are with respect to our gymnasiums and locker rooms.

## Phase 1 (Gym & Locker Room Modernization)

- All areas have been demolished, furniture and fixtures removed (see below)
- Concrete slabs have been removed
- Columns are currently being repaired in locker rooms (see right)
- Corroded pipes removed and replaced (see left)
- Bleachers, flooring have been removed in gymnasium (center)







## Pool

In May, there were concerns about fiberglass burns from athletes, and it was decided that the pool would be resurfaced during the summer. While the pool was being resurfaced, it was determined that the pool deck would be replaced. This resulted in a complete demolition of the existing pool deck. This would also make the pool deck ADA compliant. As of September 6, 2017, here is where the project stands:

- Roughly 75% of drainage has been repaired/replaced
- Within the week, gravel base will be placed as preparation for concrete pour
- Pool resurfacing has been completed



While I know this is an inconvenience for our programs and students, work is moving and I thank all students, coaches, and families for their patience.
